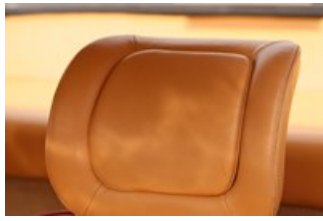


1972 Ferrari Daytona 365 GTB/4

The must-have grand tourer with its stunning Pininfarina lines, long sweeping bonnet featuring the 4.4ltr V12 quad-cam, dry sump, 6 Webber carburetted engine, producing over 350 bhp with an engaging 5-speed manual gearbox. First seen at the 1968 Paris Motor show and sort after by the rich and famous. Only 158 UK RHD cars produced, 1284 in total. The model earned its name "Daytona" with the Ferrari's domination 1-2-3 in the 1967 Daytona 24hr race. All matching numbers and owned by the same family since 1976. Well-documented history file, fully maintained with original owner's manual, bodywork spare parts catalogues and original tool bag. Finished in the Rosso Corsa with Pelle beige and red leather. Just under 38,000 genuine miles.
